ORDER VACATING ORDER NO. PSC-14-0072-FOF-TX
CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 24, 2014, Advanced Communications Southeast, Inc. (Advanced Communications Southeast) sent staff a letter requesting cancellation of its Certificate of Authority No. 8813. The Commission issued Order No. PSC-14-0072-FOF-TX on January 31, 2014, cancelling Advanced Communications Southeast's Certificate of Authority No. 8813. On February 20, 2014, Advanced Communications Southeast's letter stating that its request to cancel was made in error and was filed in the docket. Advanced Communications Southeast requests that Order No. PSC-14-0072-FOF-TX be vacated and Certificate of Authority No. 8813 be reinstated.


Since the request to cancel was erroneous, we find it appropriate to vacate Order No. PSC-14-0072-FOF-TX and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 8813, as no further Commission action is required on this matter. Upon issuance of this Order, Advanced Communications Southeast will maintain its Certificate of Authority No. 8813 as if it was never canceled.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that we hereby vacate Order No. PSC-14-0072-FOF-TX, issued January 31, 2014, and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 8813. It is further

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Office of Commission Clerk, and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure
