ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN NAME OF UTILITY

BY THE COMMISSION:

By letter dated December 12, 2023, SGI Wastewater Services, Inc. (SGI or Utility) requested that its name be officially changed to North Florida Community Water Systems, Inc. (NFCWS). We granted SGI original wastewater Certificate No. 580-S in Franklin County in 2022.¹ There have been no certificate actions since that time.

Rule 25-30.039, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), sets forth the filing requirements for changes in name only, with no change in the ownership or control of the utility or its assets. The Utility provided a statement attesting that there will be no change in the ownership or control of the Utility and its assets. The Utility also provided documentation from the Florida Department of State (DOS), Division of Corporations, regarding the Articles of Merger of SGI and NFCWS showing that NFCWS would be the surviving corporation effective January 1, 2024. The Utility also provided documentation from the DOS amending NFCWS's Articles of Incorporation, effective January 1, 2024. On February 8, 2024, the Utility filed a written affirmation stating that it mailed the approved customer notice to its customers with their bill on January 12, 2024. We have reviewed the Utility's filings and find that the request for acknowledgement of change in name is in compliance with the provisions of Rule 25-30.039, F.A.C.

Therefore, we issue this order to acknowledge the change of name on Certificate No. 580-S from SGI Wastewater Services, Inc. to North Florida Community Water Systems, Inc. This order shall serve as the Utility's wastewater certificate and shall be retained by the Utility.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the request by SGI Wastewater Services, Inc., to change its name on Certificate No. 580-S to North Florida Community Water Systems, Inc. is hereby approved. It is further

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Office of Commission Clerk, and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida

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Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
