ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATES
TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 29, 1987, we received the application of Rolling Oaks Utilities, Inc., (Utility) to amend its Certificates Nos. 215-W and 148-S to include additional territory in Citrus County, Florida, pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.061, Florida Statutes.

The applicant has submitted proof of notification to the certificated utilities and to the appropriate governmental bodies of Citrus County. Notification was given on November 5, 1986.

Notice of the Utility's intent to extend its service area was published in the Citrus County Chronicle, a newspaper of general circulation published in Citrus County, Florida, on November 6, 13, and 20, 1986.

No protests to this application were received within the prescribed time period.

The appropriate filing fee has been paid. The Utility is ready to provide service in the territory for which it applied. We have examined the application and find it to be in compliance with the law. It is, therefore,


ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificates Nos. 215-W and 148-S held by Rolling Oaks Utilities, Inc., Post Office Box 1, Beverly Hills, Florida 32665, are hereby amended to include the territory described in Appendix "A" of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that the Utility shall submit its Certificates to the Commission for amendment within 20 days of the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that the Utility shall charge the rates approved in its tariff to customers in the territory added herein. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 870109-WS is hereby closed.
