ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO FILE
DIRECT TESTIMONY OUT OF TIME

On January 3, 1989, The Florida Gas Transmission Company (FGT) filed a motion requesting that this Commission allow it to file direct testimony in this docket out of time. Direct testimony in this docket was due to be filed on December 8, 1988, with rebuttal testimony due on January 13, 1989. Simultaneous with the filing of this motion, FGT also filed a petition to intervene in this docket. That intervention motion has now been granted. On January 6, 1989, FGT filed the direct testimony of Stanley C. Horton.


Having reviewed FGT's motion, we find that its motion should be granted with the caveat that any rebuttal testimony filed in response to Mr. Horton's direct testimony be filed on or before January 23, 1989.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED BY Commissioner Gerald L. Gunter, Prehearing Officer, that the motion of Florida Gas Transmission Company for leave to file direct testimony out of time is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED that any rebuttal testimony to that of Stanley C. Horton be filed with all parties and the Commission Clerk no later than January 23, 1989.
