ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATE TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL
TERRITORY AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 26, 1988, Grand Lagoon Utilities, Inc. (Grand Lagoon or Utility) filed an application with the Commission to amend its Certificate No.123-S to include additional territory in Bay County, Florida, pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.061, Florida Statutes.

In June 1988, Grand Lagoon notified certificated utilities and appropriate governmental agencies in Bay County of its intention to amend its Certificate to include the territory described in Appendix A, attached to this Order. Proof of Notification has been furnished by the Utility.

Notice of the Utility's intent to extend its service area was published in the News-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation, published in Bay County, Florida, on June 24, July 1, and August 14, 1988. No protests to this application were received within the prescribed time period.

The appropriate filing fee has been paid, and the Utility is ready, willing and able to provide service in the territory for which it has applied. The application has been reviewed and found to be in compliance with the statutory requirements. Accordingly, we find it is in the public interest to amend Certificate No. 123-S to include the territory described in Appendix A to this Order, which by reference is incorporated herein.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificate No. 123-S, held by Grand Lagoon Utilities, Inc., 100 Delwood Beach Road, Bay Point, Panama City Beach, Florida 32407, is hereby amended to include the territory described in Appendix A of this Order. The Utility is directed to return Certificate No. 123-S to this Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order for appropriate entry. It is further

ORDERED that the customers in the territory added herein shall be charged the rates approved in the Utility's tariff. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 881402-SU is hereby closed.

Appendix 'A'

AREA DESCRIPTION/SEWER SERVICE

COMMENCE at the most Easterly Corner of Lot 11, Block 8 of the Plat of Port Lagoon, according to the Plat recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 27 in the Public Records of Bay County, Florida; thence N 58°07' W along the most Northerly line of said Lot 11 for 285.81 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; Thence N 31°53' E for 30.00 feet to the centerline of a 60-foot Access Road Right of Way; thence S 58°07' E along said Right-of-Way Centerline for 163.35 feet more or less, to a point which is 122.47 feet N 58°07' W and 30.00 feet N 31°53' E of the most Easterly corner of said Lot 11, Block 8, Plat of Port Lagoon; thence S 31°53' W to the South Right of Way Line of said 60-foot Access Road; thence S 23°09' W for 152.52 feet; thence S 59°36'21" E for 421.99 feet; thence S 31°51'07" W for 205.00 feet to a Concrete Seawall; thence N 66°17'38" W along said Seawall for 372 feet, more or less; thence N 65°43' W for 159.61 feet; thence N 22°53'E for 404.17 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Said tract containing 3.58 acres, more or less, and being located in the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 9, Township 4 South, Range 15 West.
