ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING WITHDRAWAL OF NOTICE  
AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

Florida Water Service, Inc. (FWS or the utility) gave notice in March, 1988, of its intent to amend its water Certificates Nos. 18-W and 19-W and sewer Certificate No. 14-S in Palm Beach County to include territory that the utility had been serving for a number of years. The utility stated that it believed this territory was already included in its certificates since service had been provided for more than fifteen years.

The City of Boynton Beach filed a timely objection on April 7, 1988, to the notice, formally objecting to the extension of services to Whispering Pines Mobile Home Park and requesting a hearing. FWS has subsequently contracted with the Town of Lake Clarke Shores for the sale of its systems, and filed an application for acknowledgement of this sale and cancellation of certificates in Docket No. 881498-WS.

The utility's counsel has requested withdrawal of the notice due to the sale of the systems to the Town of Lake Clarke Shores. We hereby acknowledge FWS's withdrawal of its notice of intent to apply for amendment of its Certificates Nos. 18-W, 19-W and 14-S. Since the utility has withdrawn its notice, there is no further action to be taken in this docket. Therefore, we hereby close this docket.

Based on the foregoing, it is therefore

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that this docket be closed.
