ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR FILING BRIEFS

On March 13, 1989, the Information Services Providers Alliance (ISPA) filed a Motion for Extension of Time for the Filing of Post-Hearing Briefs in this docket. Presently, briefs are due to be filed on March 24, 1989. An extension of thirty (30) days is requested.

The filing indicated that additional time to prepare briefs was required because some late-filed exhibits requested at hearing have yet to be received. The Motion stated further that parties needed additional time to thoroughly address the sixteen (16) issues raised in this docket at the level required of an important generic proceeding such as this.

Having reviewed ISPA's motion, and noting the support of said motion by other parties to this proceeding, I find that the Motion to Extend the Time for the Filing of Post-Hearing Briefs should be granted to require filing on April 24, 1989.

ORDERED that the Motion to Extend the Time for the Filing of Post-Hearing Briefs filed by the Information Services Providers Alliance is granted. Briefs should be filed on April 24, 1989.
