ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING WITHDRAWAL OF NOTICE
 AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 28, 1988, pursuant to Section 367.041, Florida Statutes, Jacksonville Suburban Utilities Commission (J.S.U.C.), filed its notice of intent to file an application to amend its certificates to provide water and sewer service in Duval County.

On November 18, 1988, the City of Jacksonville (City) filed its objection to J.S.U.C.'s proposed application. The City's objection alleged that J.S.U.C.'s notice violated the terms of a territorial service agreement between the two utilities which was acknowledged by this Commission in Order No. 19799, issued August 2, 1988.

Subsequently, on March 6, 1989, J.S.U.C. notified the Commission by letter that it was withdrawing its previously discussed notice. We hereby acknowledge J.S.U.C.'s letter of withdrawal of its notice of intent to amend its water and sewer certificates in Duval County. Thus, since no further action is required by this Commission, this docket can be closed.

Based on the foregoing, it is therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that this docket is hereby closed.
