BY THE COMMISSION:


On October 24, 31 and November 7, 1988, Laniger Enterprises of America, Inc. published notice of its intent to apply for a transfer of Certificates Nos. 362-W and 317-S from Beacon 21 Development Corporation (Beacon 21) in Martin County. By letter dated November 2, 1988, Charles and Pauline Mosony, customers of the utility, objected to the proposed transfer.

On March 20, 1989, the staff of this Commission (Staff) contacted the Mosonys to inquire about the status of their objection. Mr. Mosony informed Staff that they have moved and no longer have any interest in, or objection to, the transfer. Accordingly, by this Order, we hereby acknowledge the withdrawal of the Mosony's objection.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that this docket shall remain open in order to process the proposed transfer to Laniger Enterprises of America, Inc.
