## AMENDATORY ORDER

## BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 9, 1989, this Commission issued Order No. 21212, acknowledging a price index rate adjustment for Tradewinds Utilities, Inc. The purpose of this Order is to correct discrepancies in the Schedule on Page 1 of that Order. In the Schedule, we failed to enclose \$388 in parentheses to indicate that DER Required Water Testing is a negative amount. Further, the GNP Implicit Pice Deflator Index is shown as .0289 instead of .0435. Therefore, the Schedule is amended in its entirety as follows:
