Issue: 1. Recommendation that the interexchange carriers (IXCs) listed on Attachment A of staff's memorandum dated May 18, 1989 be required to show cause why they should not be fined \$2,000 each for failure to file the required 1988 annual reports within the prescribed time limit, which is in violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480, F.A.C. If a company does not protest or pay the fine, that company's certificate should be cancelled 30 days after issuance of the show cause order, the assessed fine should be waived, and staff should be authorized to administratively close the company's respective docket.

*Modified - a \$1,000 fine will be imposed on companies in Attachment A. of companies ~~assessments~~ <sup>may be</sup> pay \$500. within 30 days and the remaining \$500. will be suspended until the next filing is due. if that filing is late, companies must pay the remaining \$500, as well as any additional fines imposed.*

Issue: 2. Recommendation that the IXCs listed on Attachment B of staff's memorandum be required to show cause why they should not be fined \$4,000 each for failure to file the required 1988 annual reports within the prescribed time limit, for the second consecutive year, which is in violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480. If a company does not protest or pay the fine, that company's certificate should be cancelled 30 days after issuance of the show cause order, the assessed fine should be waived, and staff should be authorized to administratively close the company's respective docket.

*Modified - Alltelco and 800 Telpatch will be required to show cause why they should not be fined \$4000 each. The remaining ~~of~~ companies on Attachment B will be fined \$4000 with \$2000 suspended if \$2000 is paid within 30 days. The suspended \$2000, plus any additional fines, will be due if next filing is late.*

Issue: 3. Recommendation that the Commission not accept MCI's offer of settlement of a reduced fine for violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480. Staff recommends that the show cause order recommended under Issue No. 2 include MCI.

*Issue covered in Issue 2 - Moot*

Issue: 4. Recommendation that the Commission not accept National Telephone Service's (NTS's) offer of settlement of a reduced fine for violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480. Staff recommends that the show cause order recommended under Issue No. 2 include NTS.

*Issue covered in Issue 1 - Moot*

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Issue: 5. Recommendation that the Commission issue a proposed agency action order accepting Card\*Tel's \$500 offer in settlement of this docket for violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480 but rejecting Card\*Tel's insufficient offer to pay \$1,500 if the Company's 1989 annual report is untimely filed.

*Issue covered in Issue 1 - Moot*

Issue: 6. Recommendation that the IXCs on Attachment C of staff's memorandum be required to show cause why they should not have their certificates cancelled for failure to file the required 1988 annual reports, which is in violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480.

*Modified - companies will be required to show cause why their certificates should not be revoked and/or why they should not be fined \$10,000.*

Issue: 7. Recommendation that the Commission order all LECs and IXCs to discontinue intrastate service to the companies whose certificates are cancelled as a result of these show cause proceedings.

*Matter will be handled if it is necessary to  
cancel certificates*

Issue: 8. Recommendation that these dockets be held open pending payment of fines. If the fine is paid within 30 days after issuance of the order, then staff will be authorized by the Commission to administratively close these dockets. If the fine is not paid within 30 days after issuance of the order or a protest is not received by the Commission, the IXC's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be cancelled and fines waived, after which staff is authorized to administratively close these dockets.
