COMES NOW Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company (Southern Bell or Company), pursuant to Rule Rule 22.037, Florida Administrative Code, and files its Motion for Extension of Time in which to respond to Order No. 21453, in the above-referenced docket, and as grounds therefore states:

1. On May 2, 1989, Southern Bell filed its Request for Specified Confidential Classification regarding certain traffic studies filed with the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission). On July 13, 1989, Southern Bell discovered that on June 26, 1989, the Prehearing Officer denied Southern Bell's request for confidentiality in Order No. 21453. Southern Bell did not receive a copy of that order.

2. On July 13, 1989, Southern Bell contacted the attorney for AT&T and was informed that AT&T also did not receive a copy of Order No. 21453. Subsequently, Southern Bell contacted the Commission clerk and was informed by the clerk's office that there may have been an error in disseminating Order No. 21453 to all the parties of record.

3. Southern Bell received a copy of Order No. 21453 at 4:00 PM on July 13, 1989. Because of the delay in Southern Bell's receipt of the order, Southern Bell is requesting a 14-day extension from today's date in order to prepare and file its Protest of Order No. 21453.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing reasons, Southern Bell is requesting and Extension of Time in which to respond to Order No. 21453.
