ORDER DISMISSING PETITION AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 1, 1989, Central Florida Gas Company ("CFGC") filed a petition for approval of modifications to its approved conservation program. In its petition, CFGC sought the Commission's approval for modification of its single and multi-family residential home builder program. Specifically, CFGC requested that it be allowed to increase the installation allowance used to assist in defraying additional cost of gas piping and appliance venting required to install gas appliances.

On October 26, 1989, a request to withdraw petition was filed by CFGC pursuant to Commission Rule 25-22.035(3) and Rule of Civil Procedure 1.420(a)(a). Pursuant to these rules, the petitioner can withdraw his petition at any time prior to the submittal of his case to the trier of fact.

In consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that the petition be dismissed. It is further

ORDERED that this docket be closed on January 13, 1990, if no Motion for Reconsideration or Notice of Appeal is timely filed prior to that time.
