ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 9, 1989, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) filed a petition for resolution of a territorial dispute with Florida Power Corporation (FPC), initiating Docket No. 890646-EI. Investigation ensued and a hearing was scheduled for November 27, 1989. On November 15, 1989, TECO filed a petition for settlement of that dispute, and the hearing was cancelled. Concurrent with that proposed settlement, TECO filed a proposed tariff as Docket No. 891300-EI. The tariff filing is an integral part of the proposed settlement agreement.

The proposed tariff filing was received on November 15, 1989. Under the file and suspend procedures, unless we suspend the tariff, it will become effective after sixty days.

This is a unique tariff which may effect future Commission policy. We believe that additional study by our staff is necessary before we can approve or deny it. Therefore, the tariff filed in this docket should be suspended to remove the 60

day deadline and to allow our staff adequate time to review all aspects of the proposed filing.


In addition, this tariff filing should be considered in conjunction with and at the same time as the proposed settlement in Docket No. 890646-EI. To obtain a clear picture of the costs and benefits associated with the proposed tariff and settlement, information from both dockets must be considered. Since the territorial agreement is contingent upon approval of the tariff, it is more efficient to address both dockets at the same time to avoid duplication of effort.

In consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the tariff filed in this docket by Tampa Electric Company is hereby suspended. It is further

ORDERED that the tariff filing in this docket be considered in conjunction with and on the same time schedule as the proposed settlement in Docket No. 890646-EI.
