Please find enclosed Resolution #89-M118 adopted by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners on December 11, 1989. This resolution respectfully request and recommends the Florida Public Service Commission initiate a proceeding under Commission Rule 25-4.057, F.A.C., to investigate the need and feasibility for extended area or County-wide local telephone service for the residents of Orange County within the Mt. Dora telephone exchange.

The Mt. Dora telephone exchange is primarily based in Lake County; however, a portion of Orange County is in this service area. The residents and business owners of the Orange County portion of this exchange are charged a long distance toll for each telephone call placed to other communities within Orange County. Specifically, the customers of the Orange County portion of the Mt. Dora exchange desire extended area or local (toll free) service to the following exchanges: Apopka, Orlando, Winter Garden, East Orange, Lake Buena Vista, Reedy Creek, Windermere, and Winter Park.

Orange County appreciates the consideration granted to this request by the Florida Public Service Commission, as well as your gracious assistance throughout this process.

RESOLUTION NO. 89-M-118

WHEREAS, a portion of Northwest Orange County, including the communities of Tangerine and Zellwood, is provided telephone service through United Telephone System's Mount Dora exchange; and,

WHEREAS, the residents of the Orange County portion of the Mount Dora exchange desire extended area or local (toll free) service to the remainder of Orange County, specifically the following exchanges: Apopka, Orlando, Winter Garden, Winter Park, East Orange, Reedy Creek, Windermere, and Lake Buena Vista; and,

WHEREAS, the residents and businesses of Orange County within the Mount Dora exchange are excluded from toll-free service to the remainder of Orange County and are, therefore, denied unified toll-free access to the essential governmental, educational and public services provided by, and within Orange County; and,

WHEREAS, the residents of said portion of Orange County have requested the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County assist them in acquiring local (toll-free) telephone service to all of Orange County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County desires to officially request the Florida Public Service Commission investigate the feasibility of providing extended or County-wide service to these residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:
