This docket was initiated on account of an application filed by Betmar Utilities, Inc. (Betmar) for amendment of water and sewer certificates in Pasco County. The application was filed on November 13, 1989. On November 21, 1989, staff mailed Betmar a letter informing the utility that it must comply with the notice provisions of newly enacted Section 367.045, Florida Statutes. Pasco County filed an objection to Betmar's notice of amendment on November 27, 1989, and restated such objection on December 26, 1989, after Betmar renoticed under the new statute.

following reasons for the Pasco County states Betmar's service extension of objection: the proposed and uneconomic unnecessary territory would result in duplication of water and sewer services in light of the existing facilities and service capabilities of Pasco County; MEMORANDUM - NANETTE FISHER DOCKET NO. 891280-WS FEBRUARY 19, 1990

would violate Pasco County's Local Government Comprehensive Plan; and would be inconsistent with Section 163.3194, Florida Statutes. Pasco County further states that Betmar has been under enforcement action by the Department of Environmental Regulation for approximately the last four years regarding its wastewater treatment plant.

By phone conversation on February 19, 1990, Betmar indicated its desire to proceed with a formal hearing to dispose of Pasco County's objection. Based on the foregoing, staff recommends that this matter be set for hearing. Because there are two parties that will participate as adversaries regarding issues that are primarily factual, we believe this case may be appropriate for referral to the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH).
