ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

In May of 1986, the Commission opened this docket to amend the water and sewer annual report rule so that the Commission's annual report forms would conform to the new NARUC Uniform System of Accounts for Water and Sewer Utilities.

The office of Public Counsel (Public Counsel) intervened in the docket and requested that an additional rate of return report be included in the annual report form.

Members of the industry objected to inclusion of the additional twelve-page report, because they believed it would be unduly costly to complete.

We voted to adopt staff's proposed amendments to the annual report rule on September 16, 1986, but we did not adopt Public Counsel's proposal. Instead we held the docket open for further review of Public Counsel's proposal.

Public Counsel and the water and sewer industry have been unable to reach any agreement over what a rate of return report should entail, and, as a result, nothing has been done in this docket for the past eighteen months.
