ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN NAME OF UTILITY

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 27, 1972, by Order No. 5608, Certificate No. 82-S was issued in the name of R.W. Caldwell, Jr., d/b/a SCE Services. On April 4, 1990, SCE Services was incorporated by the Division of Corporations, Department of State, under the name SCE Services, Inc. By letter dated April 19, 1990, R.W. Caldwell, Jr., requested that the name on the certificate be changed from R. W. Caldwell, Jr., d/b/a SCE Services to SCE Services, Inc. Our review indicates no change in ownership has taken place; that is, R.W. Caldwell, Jr., is the sole shareholder of SCE Services, Inc. Based on the foregoing, the utility's request to change the name on Certificate No. 82-S to SCE Services, Inc., is hereby approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the request to change the name of R.W. Caldwell, Jr., d/b/a SCE Services shown on Certificate No. 82-S to SCE Services, Inc., is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that Certificate No. 82-S shall be returned to the Commission by the close of business on June 30, 1990, for entry indicating SCE Services, Inc., as the name of the utility. It is further

ORDERED that the utility shall by June 30, 1990, submit revised tariff sheets which reflect the fact that the name of the utility has been changed. It is further

ORDERED that this docket is closed.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or sewer utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
