1. Paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 are admitted.
2. FPL denies paragraph 4a only in regard to the use of the term "transmission line" and otherwise admits paragraph 4a.
3. FPL denies the second sentence of paragraph 4b and admits the first sentence thereof.
4. FPL is without knowledge sufficient to respond to paragraph 4c and it is therefore denied, except that FPL admits that it did render service to the Huntsville General Store on November 3, 1989.
5. FPL denies the first and second sentences of paragraph 4d and admits the rest of paragraph 4d.
6. FPL denies paragraph 4e.
7. FPL denies paragraph 5.

8. FPL extended service to the Huntsville General Store upon receipt of a written request from the Store's attorney, Frank M. Gafford. FPL provided service pursuant to its statutory obligation to serve as set forth in §366.03, Florida Statutes.


WHEREFORE, FPL requests that the Commission take jurisdiction of this matter and resolve the territorial dispute.
