Subject: FPSC Audit Request No. 8 Regarding Payment for ANF Supervisor to Travel to PSL for Fitness for Duty Training and to Review Exam Procedures with Site Personnel

On June 21, 1990 we received Document/Record Request No. 8 from the FPSC auditors. As we discussed in our meeting of June 25, 1990, with the FPSC auditors and yourself, our response is as follows:

1. Yes. FPL did pay for an ANF supervisor to travel to St. Lucie. The main purpose of the trip was to hold a pre-meeting with FPL personnel to discuss the work to be performed (oxide thickness measurement). At the time, it was decided that the supervisor should also go through the health physics training and security review that is required by the NRC for any personnel that will have "unescorted access" to the nuclear plant site.

Since ANF is located in the state of Washington, the trip required four days of his time - one day to travel down, two days at the plant site, and one day to travel back. FPL was billed for all of his time (approximately 32 hours at a rate specified in the contract of between \$149.00 and \$197.00 per hour, depending on the supervisor's classification). The balance of the \$8450 is comprised of the supervisor's airplane fare, hotel room costs, meal expenses, transportation, etc.

2. Yes. This type of expense is recurring since the health physics training and security review are required by the NRC for "unescorted access" to the nuclear plant site. Normally, the costs for this training are "embedded" within the costs quoted by the vendors; since the pre-meeting trip was not originally planned, the costs associated were broken out in the Letter of Authorization.

Since the pre-meeting at the plant site was helpful in planning the work, FPL anticipates holding similar meetings in the future for such projects.
