STIPULATION

Florida Power Corporation (FPC) and Clay Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Clay) hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Clay and FPC are currently involved in a territorial dispute filed with the Florida Public Service Commission over a rural area north of Archer, Florida as more fully identified in Clay's Petition. Clay and FPC are currently engaged in negotiations to settle their service areas in Alachua County, including the area in dispute, subject, however, to the approval of the Florida Public Service Commission.

2. FPC has received from Alachua County a permit to construct power lines along the eastern and northern boundaries of the disputed area which lines will serve a customer who has requested service at a location within the disputed area.

3. The construction of the facilities by FPC necessary to serve the requesting customer shall be without prejudice to the rights or interest of any party to these proceedings.

4. In the event that the territorial dispute is not settled by negotiation, FPC and Clay agree that only those facilities that were existing as of the date of the filing of the Petition by Clay shall be used and identified as "existing facilities" in the Public Service Commission proceeding.


