MOTION TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW the Office of Statewide Prosecution by and through the undersigned pursuant to Chapter 25.22, Florida Administrative Code and Chapter 120, Florida Statutes and requests permission to intervene in this docketed matter. As grounds therefore the Office of Statewide Prosecution alleges as follows:

- 1. The Office of Statewide Prosecution was created by authority of Chapter 16.56, Florida Statutes. The office is responsible for the prosecution of crimes enumerated therein that impact more than one judicial circuit.
- 2. Under Chapter 934, Florida Statutes, the Statewide Prosecutor is an authorizing official for wiretaps and other intercepts and Assistant Statewide Prosecutors are assigned to work on matters regulated by Chapter 934, Florida Statutes.
- 3. Assistant Statewide Prosecutors frequently give legal advise to undercover agents, work with civilian informants and others who assist law enforcement in the investigation of crimes.
- 4. The proposed Southern Bell Tariff herein adversely affects the ability of this office to assist in the conduct of such investigations and prosecute cases within its jurisdiction.
