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3. The substantial interests of Panda will be affected by Commission action in this Docket. On May 25, 1990 the Commission voted to designate a 500MW coal-fired unit, with an in-service date of January 1, 1996, as the statewide avoided unit under Rule 25-17.083. On July 24, 1990 Panda executed a standard offer contract and interconnection agreement for a 230MW cogeneration facility to be located in Suwannee County. The standard offer contract and interconnection agreement were submitted to Florida Power Corporation on July 25 and 30, 1990, respectively. At present,

there are over 2,500MW of potential QF contracts signed and/or submitted to Florida Utilities for the 1996 500MW avoided unit. The Commission must either expand the subscription limit or identify which contracts are entitles to participate in the 500MW subscription limit. As a result, the substantial interests of Panda are subject to determination or will be affected by this proceeding.

WHEREFORE Panda/Live Oak Corporation requests entry of an order granting it leave to intervene in the above proceedings.
