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

Brief For Mockingbird Energy Corporation

Mockingbird Energy Corporation ("Mockingbird") files this brief in support of its proposed 220 net megawatt gas fired combined cycle power plant to be located in the city of Dania, Broward County, Florida (the "Plant").

Mockingbird began discussions with Florida Power & Light Company ("FP & L") and development of the Plant earlier this year. By July, Mockingbird had located potential sites for the Plant as well as a steam host. On July 25, 1990, after meeting with FP & L and analyzing FP & L's Standard Offer Contract, Mockingbird elected to sign the Standard Offer Contract as well as FP & L's Standard Interconnection Agreement. Since July, Mockingbird has entered into an agreement in principle for delivery of the required fuel supply for the Plant.

Mockingbird believes that FP & L should execute its Standard Offer Contract and the Commission should approve the Contract because (1) the terms of the contract signed by Mockingbird are those proposed by FP & L with Commission approval, (2) FP & L and Florida need the power which will be supplied by the Plant, (3) Mockingbird has located its Plant at a site that is very favorable to FP & L's system, (4) the site is located in an industrial area so that it should be easily permitable and (5) Mockingbird has an agreement in principle for the Plants' required fuel supply.
