PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of the proceeding shall be to determine the methodology and criteria to be employed by the Commission to determine which contracts for the purchase of Qualifying Facility (QF) power should be selected to fill the 500 MW subscription limit previously defined by the Commission. Once the methodology and criteria is established by the Commission, if no disputed issues of material fact arise, the Commission shall prioritize contract subscription to the 500 MW limit. The proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Section 120.57(2), Florida Statutes.

The purpose of this prehearing conference will be to consider: (1) the simplification of the issues; (2) the identification of the positions of the parties on the issues; (3) the possibility of obtaining admissions of fact and of documents which will avoid unnecessary proof; (4) The possibility of obtaining waiver of a Section 120.57(1) Formal Proceeding; (5) the question of whether disputed issues of material fact are involved; and (6) such other matters as may aid in the disposition of the action.

JURISDICTION

Jurisdiction over this matter is vested in the Commission by Chapter 366, Florida Statutes. This proceeding will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, as well as Chapters 25-6 and 25-22, Florida Administrative Code.
