Issue 3: Recommendation that the Commission issue the proposed declaratory statement which answers Seminole's petition in the negative. Denial is appropriate because the issue raised concerns this Commission's jurisdiction. A legal determination is being requested which should be consistent with Florida and federal precedents. Those precedents allow for ordinary leases of cogeneration equipment and for sale-leaseback financing of such equipment. There is, however, no precedent for the proposal before us, where a lessee cogenerates power, a lessor non-cogenerator owns and sells some of that power to utilities, and the expense of power production is shared between the two.

DENIED

<u>Alternative Recommendation:</u> The Commission could, as a matter of policy, grant the petition.

APPROVED WITH THE STIPULATION THAT BOTH SEMINOLE FERTILIZER CORPORATION AND THE LIMITED PARTNERSHIP SEEK AND RECEIVE a "QUALIFYING FACILITY" DESIGNATION.
