Dear Mr. Deterding:

Staff has reviewed your application for transfer of the Century Group, Inc. utilities in Pasco County to B.D.C., Inc. Before we can process your request, the following deficiencies will need to be filed:

1. The affidavit that the notice of actual application was published once each week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Pasco County, pursuant to Rules 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code. A copy of the proof of publication should accompany the affidavit.
2. Provide the First, Second, Third, and any other Amendments, all Exhibits, including Exhibit C (the Pasco County letter), and any other attachments to the Purchase and Sale Agreement, as required by Rule 25-30.037(1)(g), Florida Administrative Code.
3. Provide a statement as to why the utility should not be fined for the transfer of the water utility without prior Commission approval, as required by Section 367.071(2), Florida Statutes.

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According to the Commission records, Century Group, Inc. is delinquent in paying its regulatory assessment fees for the water utility for the second half of 1989 and the 1990 calendar year and for the wastewater utility for the 1990 calendar year. According to the application, Section XV, "Any outstanding regulatory fees, fines or refunds owed up to the date of transfer are the responsibility of the Transferor...." Payment of the 1989 regulatory assessment fees were due March 31, 1990 and must be paid as soon as possible. The 1990 regulatory assessment fees are due by March 31, 1991.
