I am in receipt of your letter dated April 30, 1991, addressed to Harold Haimowitz. I firmly believe that your Rule 25-24.474 (1)(d) is unfair as it relates to CARD\*TEL's situation. It was through great effort and much expense that we obtained our IXC Certificate. Although we are not providing service at this time nor have we provided service in the past, it has always been our intention to provide service in the future. This particular Rule would penalize a company which obtained a Certificate if they did not get into business within six months.

Based upon your expressing in your April 30 letter that the staff is going to recommend to the Commission that our Certificate be canceled, we reluctantly have determined it is in our best interest to voluntarily cancel our Certificate without penalty. We, therefore, by this letter agree to the cancellation on a voluntary basis.
