


As you know, the Commission issued an Order in the above-
referenced docket on May 20, 1991. That Order denied Southern
Bell's tariff filings concerning Caller ID and permissible dis-
closure of non-published telephone numbers. It requires
Southern Bell to modify these tariffs in certain, specific
respects if the company wishes to offer Caller ID service. The
Order also sets forth actions that Southern Bell must take with
regard to other of its CLASS services.

By its terms, the Order applies only to Southern Bell. It does
not address other companies' tariff filings with regard to
Caller ID or any other service. Based on this understanding,
GTE Florida Incorporated ("GTEFL") will not seek reconsideration
of the Order. Of course, GTEFL reserves the right to dispute
any rule or policy that the Commission may later apply to any
GTEFL service.
