CASE BACKGROUND

By Order No. 24178 dated February 28, 1991, the Commission ordered Central Telephone Company of Florida (Centel) and Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company (Southern Bell) to implement the \$.25 calling plan on interLATA routes between Southern Bell's Graceville exchange and Centel's Ponce De Leon and DeFuniak Springs exchanges.

Southern Bell was directed to seek a waiver of Judge Greene's Modified Final Judgement. The waiver has not been granted to date and Southern Bell is seeking an extension of time to implement the \$.25 plan on these interLATA routes.

DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should Southern Bell's Motion for an Extension of Time to implement the \$.25 calling plan on the interLATA routes between Graceville and Ponce De Leon and DeFuniak Springs be granted?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. Southern Bell's Motion should be granted.

<u>STAFF ANALYSIS:</u> The Commission, in the Centel Rate Case (Docket No. 891246-TL) ordered Southern Bell and Centel to implement the \$.25 calling plan on several routes, two of which were interLATA routes. Those routes are between Graceville (Southern Bell) and Ponce De Leon and DeFuniak Springs (Centel).

Southern Bell was directed to seek a waiver of Judge Greene's Modified Final Judgement. The waiver has not been received, therefore the plan cannot be implemented. Staff recommends the Motion for Extension of Time be granted until such time as the waiver is received. Normally we would not recommend an open end extension, however in this particular case it should be open ended. Attachments A and B are copies of Southern Bell's and Centel's Motion and Response, respectively.

ISSUE 2: Should these dockets be closed.

RECOMMENDATION: Yes, with the exception of Docket No. 880069-TL (Southern Bell's Rate Stabilization), the dockets should be closed. Staff should place the matter on monitor status to ensure that the \$.25 plan (or the nonoptional, flat rate two-way plan, if approved at the July 30, 1991 Agenda Conference) is implemented on these two interLATA routes.

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

SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO IMPLEMENT A \$.25 PER MESSAGE INTRACOUNTY CALLING PLAN BETWEEN THE GRACEVILLE TO PONCE DE LEON AND DEFUNIAK SPRINGS EXCHANGES IN HOLMES AND WALTON COUNTIES

COMES NOW, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell"), and files its Motion For Extension of Time In Which to Implement a \$.25 Per Message Intracounty Calling Plan ("Calling Plan") Between the Graceville to Ponce de Leon and Defuniak Springs Exchanges in Holmes and Walton Counties.

1. By Orders numbered 24178 issued February 28, 1991 and 24178-A issued May 20, 1991 in these dockets, the Commission



issued a notice of proposed agency action requiring the implementation of the Calling Plan between the Graceville to Ponce de Leon and Defuniak Springs Exchanges which exchanges are in different LATAS (the "InterLATA Routes") in Holmes and Walton Counties. The Commission's Orders required implementation of the Calling Plan on the InterLATA Routes by July 1, 1991.

- 2. On May 29, 1991, pursuant to procedures set forth by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia (the "Court") in <u>United States v. Western Electric Company and American Telephone and Telegraph Company</u>, Civil Action No. 82-0192-HHG, Southern Bell filed a Request for a Waiver of the Modification of Final Judgment ("MFJ") with the Department of Justice ("DOJ") for the purpose of implementing the Calling Plan on the InterLATA Routes.
- 3. As of the date of this filing, Southern Bell has not been able to obtain the MFJ Waiver from the Court. Furthermore, the DOJ has informally advised Southern Bell that the Waiver Request is still under consideration at the DOJ and that a recommendation by the DOJ to the Court will not be immediately forthcoming.
- 4. Because Southern Bell cannot lawfully implement the Calling Plan on the InterLATA Routes without an MFJ Waiver, it is appropriate to extend the time in which to implement the Calling Plan until a Waiver is granted by the Court.

WHEREFORE, Southern Bell respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion For Extension of Time to implement the Calling Plan on the InterLATA Routes until a Waiver of the MFJ is granted by the Court.
