Issue 3: Recommendation that International Telecommunications Exchange Corporation be required to show cause in writing why it should not be fined for violation of Chapter 25-24.470, F.A.C., Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Required, for providing intrastate communications without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission.

MODIFIED

Fine limit is set at \$3,000.

Issue 4: Recommendation that a certificate be granted to International Telecommunications Exchange Corporation to operate as an interexchange telephone company in Florida. If a show cause order is issued, this docket should remain open for that proceeding. If no show cause order is issued, this docket should be closed after the effective date of the proposed agency action order, if no protest is received.
