Dear Mike:

Pursuant to our recent telephone conversations, please consider this letter the joint request of CFR Bio-Gen Corporation and Florida Power Corporation with respect to the matters hereinafter discussed. Jim Fama of Florida Power Corporation has authorized me to make this request on behalf of both of our clients.

FPC and CFR have entered into good faith negotiations whereby FPC has agreed to extend the QF in-service date and FPC has agreed to consent to CFR's assignment of its contract, in return for CFR's locating its project south of FPC's Central Florida Substation and making its project dispatchable. These negotiations have led to the attached Stipulation, which in turn, is intended to result in the negotiation and execution of a new contract (Contract) for the purchase of 74 MW of electrical generation and cause the prior two contracts to be terminated.

The parties intend to finalize this Contract within 45 days of the date of the Stipulation, that is, on or before November 11, 1991. Except for terms expressly reserved by the Stipulation for further negotiation, the Contract will be in the same form as those FPC negotiated QF contracts approved by the Commission in 1991. The 45 days is needed to craft dispatch provisions which, to date,

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have not been employed in any of FPC's QF contracts.

In order to allow time to complete contract negotiations the parties request that the Case Assignment and Record Dates (CASR) dates in this case be changed as follows:
