RE: DOCKET NO. 870790-TL - Request by Gilchrist County Commissioners for extended area service throughout Gilchrist County.

Issue 1: Recommendation that Southern Bell's and ALLTEL's proposed settlement of the issues which were set for hearing in this docket should be accepted. Calls on the Branford/High Springs, Branford/Newberry, Branford/Trenton, High Springs/Trenton, and Newberry/Trenton routes should be rated at \$.25 per call, regardless of call duration. These calls should be furnished on a seven-digit basis. Non-LEC pay telephone providers should charge end users as if these calls were local \$.25 calls. ALLTEL and Southern Bell should be ordered to implement this change by July 1, 1992. Southern Bell should immediately seek a waiver of the Modification of Final Judgement (MFJ) from Judge Greene to carry the traffic on these routes.
