SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S
REQUEST FOR WAIVER FOR A PORTION OF ORDER NO. 25772

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a/
Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell")
and hereby moves that the Florida Public Service Commission (the
"Commission") grant a waiver exempting Southern Bell from certain
reporting requirements contained in Order No. 25772. In support
hereof, Southern Bell shows the following:

1. In Docket No. 910528-TL, the Commission considered a
resolution filed with it by the Putnam County Board of County
Commissioners, which resolution sought implementation of extended
area service among various exchanges within Putnam County.

2. By Order No. 25772, the Commission denied the Putnam
County Board of County Commissioners' request for extended area
service, but did, however, require implementation of an
alternative toll plan. That alternative toll plan will provide
calls between the affected exchanges on a \$.25 per call basis.
As a part of this order, the Commission required that Southern

Bell file certain quarterly reports with the Commission Staff.

This requirement is set forth at page 7 of the Order as follows:

Finally, following implementation of the calling plan, the companies shall file quarterly reports with our staff, broken down on a monthly basis. These reports shall include a detailed analysis of the distribution of calling usage among subscribers, over each route, segregated between business and residential users and combined, showing for each category the number of customers making zero (0) calls, one (1) call, et cetera, through twenty-five (25) calls, and in ten (10) call increments thereafter, to ninety-five (95) calls, and ninety-six (96) or more calls. These reports on usage shall be filed for a one year period following implementation. These usage reports shall also include a record of any customer contact, along with the reason for such contact, regarding the \$.25 calling plan.


3. Southern Bell hereby requests that the Commission waive the reporting requirement imposed on it as described in paragraph 2 above. Southern Bell does not believe that the information sought in these reports will provide the Commission with information that is necessary to determine the success or not of the implementation of the \$.25 plan in Putnam County. Moreover, it would be extremely burdensome and expensive for Southern Bell to compile this information for the Commission. Given the highly burdensome nature of compiling the information required by such a report versus the relative lack of need for such information,

Southern Bell respectfully requests that the Commission waive this reporting requirement insofar as Southern Bell is concerned.


4. WHEREFORE, Southern Bell requests that the reporting requirements found on page 7 of Order No. 25772 be waived.
