 RE: MERGER OF SOUTHERN STATES AND UNITED FLORIDA UTILITIES CORPORATION

As you know, Order No. 25575, issued in Docket No. 910662-WS, acknowledged the corporate reorganization of Southern States with the Deltona and United Florida systems and directed Southern States to advise the Commission within twenty days of the completion of the merger. Staff has been advised by letter that the merger of Southern States and the United Florida systems took place on April 1, 1992. However, the merger of the Deltona systems will not occur until some time in the future.

This is to advise you that the following utilities have been merged with Southern States:

In this regard, the certificates of Citrus Springs, Pine Ridge and Marion Oaks will be cancelled and the certificates held by Southern States in Citrus and Marion Counties will be amended to include these systems. Since Southern States currently has no certificates in Washington County, Certificates Nos. 501W and 435S will be transferred from Sunny Hills to Southern States.
