Dear Sir:

This letter is being sent as preliminary notice that on or before August 1, 1992, SunCoast Pipeline Company, a Texas General Partnership, will be filing with your Bureau an Application for a Determination of Need for an Intrastate Natural Gas Transmission Pipeline, pursuant to Section 403.9422(2)(b) of the Florida Statutes.

SunCoast will own and operate an intrastate natural gas transmission pipeline in the State of Florida. As currently proposed, the SunCoast system will originate at a point near Walnut Hill, Florida and will extend east and south ultimately terminating at Florida Power & Light's Port Everglades electric power generation unit. It is also proposed that numerous lateral lines will extend off the SunCoast mainline system, to wit: from a point in Gilchrist County to a point in Northern Duval County; from a point in Pasco County to a point in Tarpon Springs, Pinellas County; and from points in Polk County to points in Hardee County.

SunCoast's Application will contain all of the requisite information necessary to support the filing.
