AMENDATORY ORDER

By Order No. PSC-92-0992-FOF-TL, issued September 15, 1992, we rendered our final decision after hearing in this docket.

Shortly after issuance of Order No. PSC-92-0992-FOF-TL, it came to our attention that there was a typographical error in the first sentence of the last paragraph on Page 5 of the Order. Presently that sentence reads:

We find that the calling rates and call distribution on the Sanford/Apopka and Sanford/Geneva routes do not demonstrate a sufficient community of interest to justify EAS or any alternative toll relief plan.

That statement is not correct. In actuality, that sentence should read:

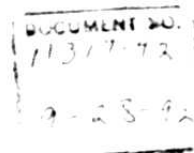

Accordingly, Order No. PSC-92-0992-FOF-TL shall be so amended.

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-92-0992-FOF-TL is hereby amended to the extent outlined in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-92-0992-FOF-TL is hereby affirmed in all other respects.
