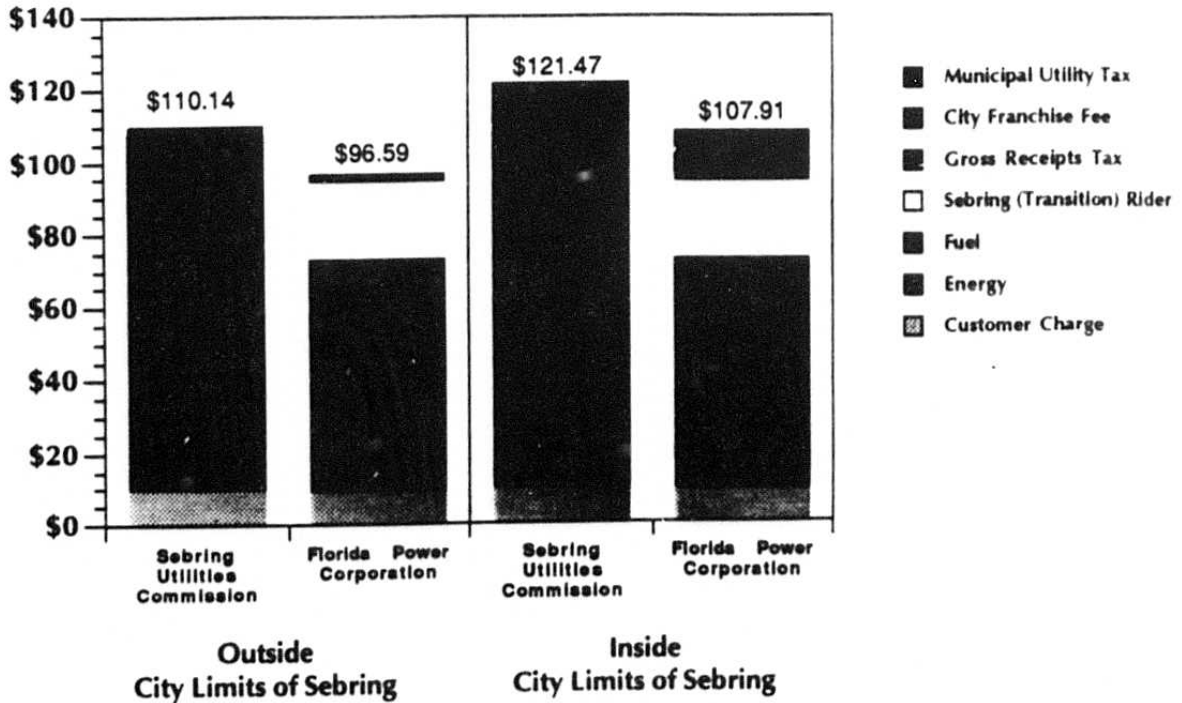

Energy Usage of 1,000 kWh

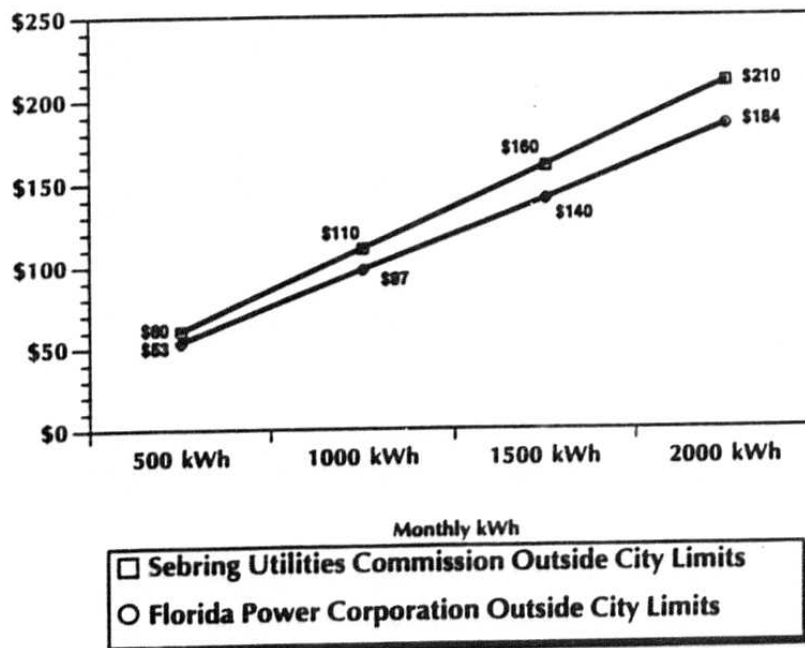
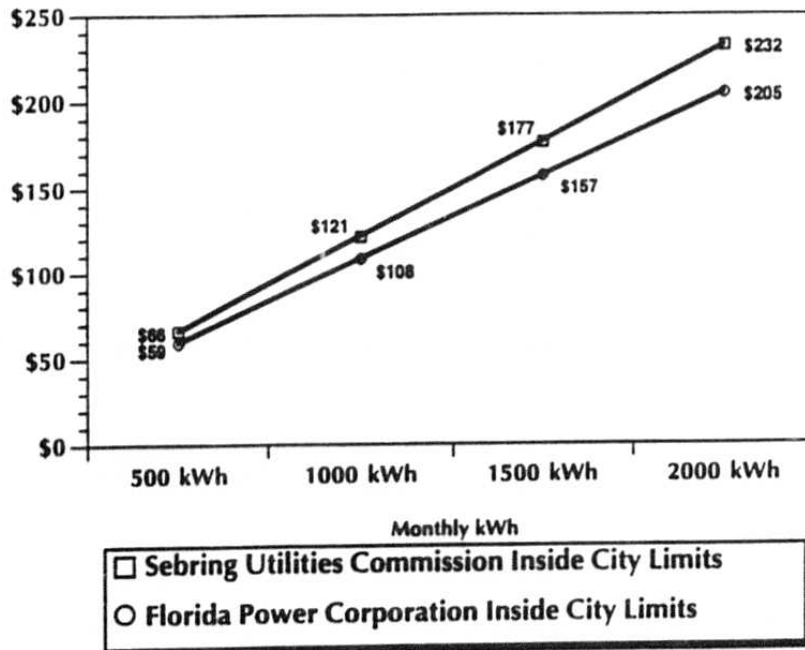

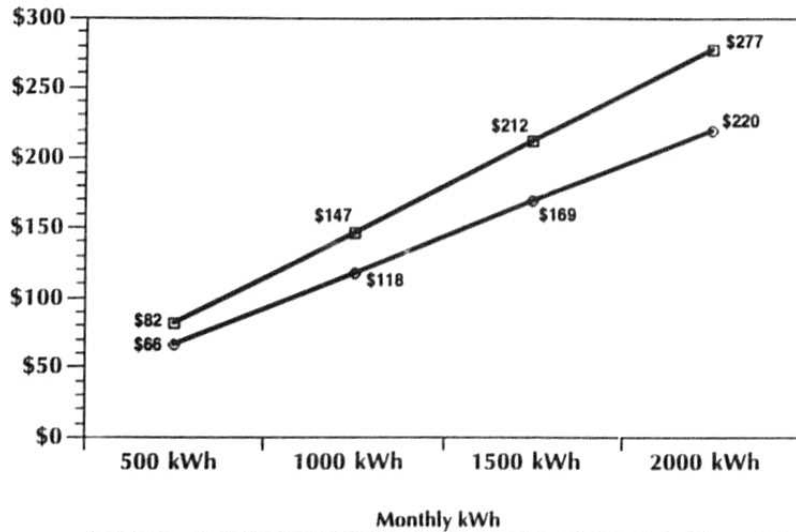
# RESIDENTIAL Rate Comparison



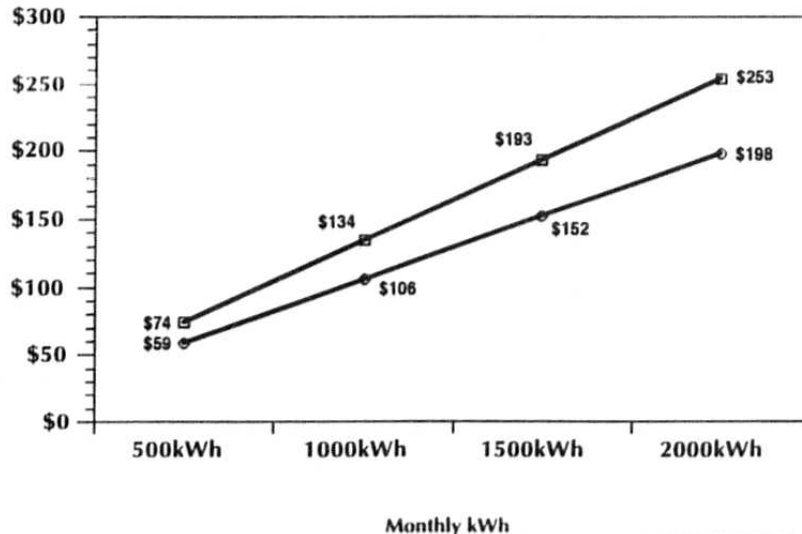

 Florida Power Corporation Inside City Limits

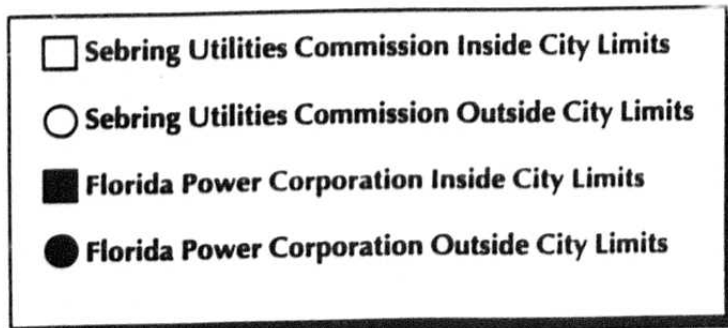
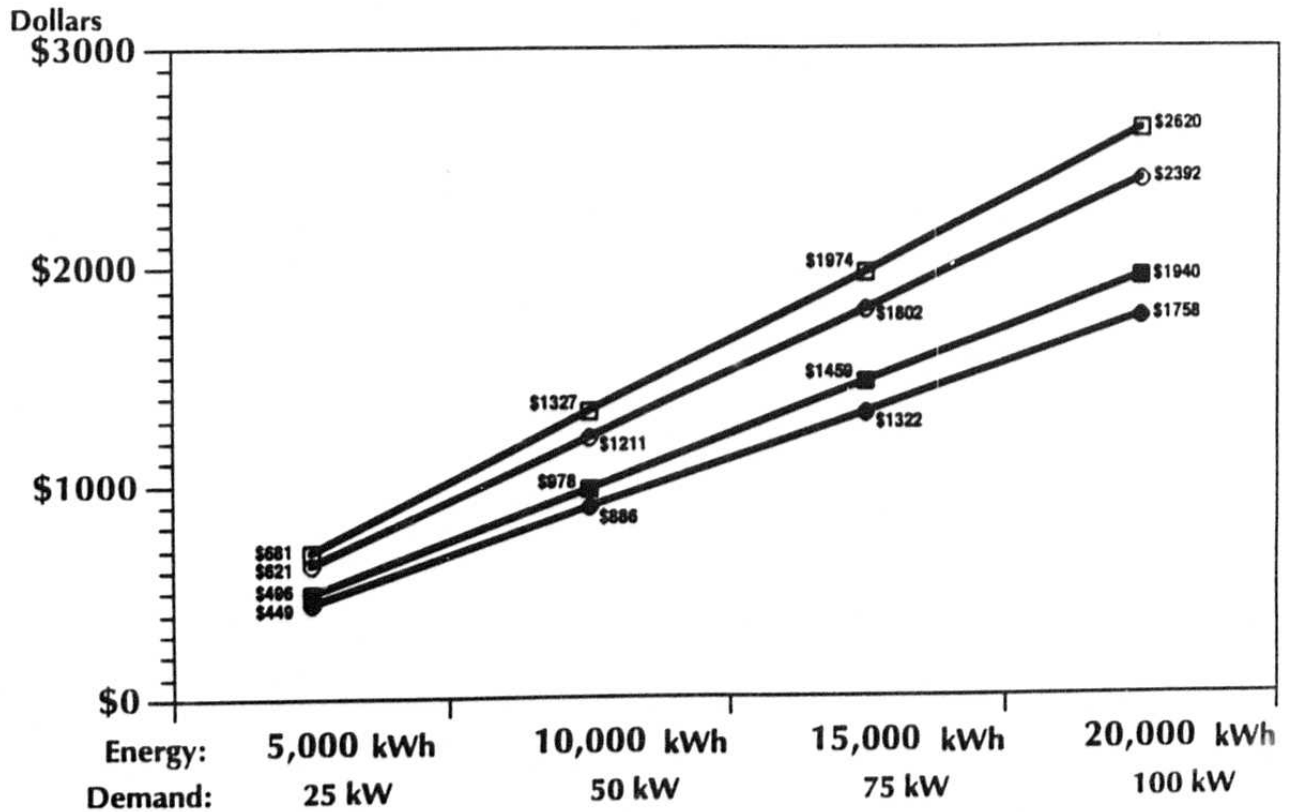


Sebring Utilities Commission Outside City Limits

# GENERAL SERVICE DEMAND Rate Comparison Load Factor of 27%

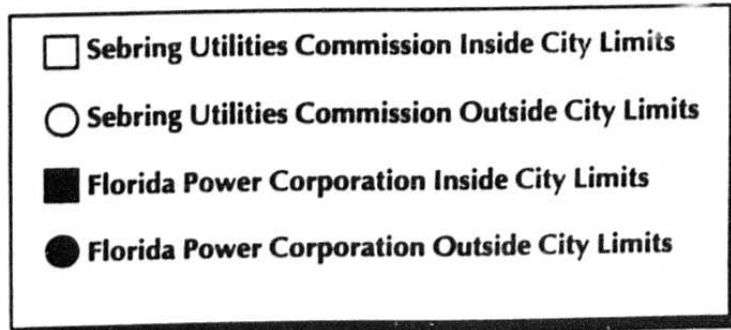
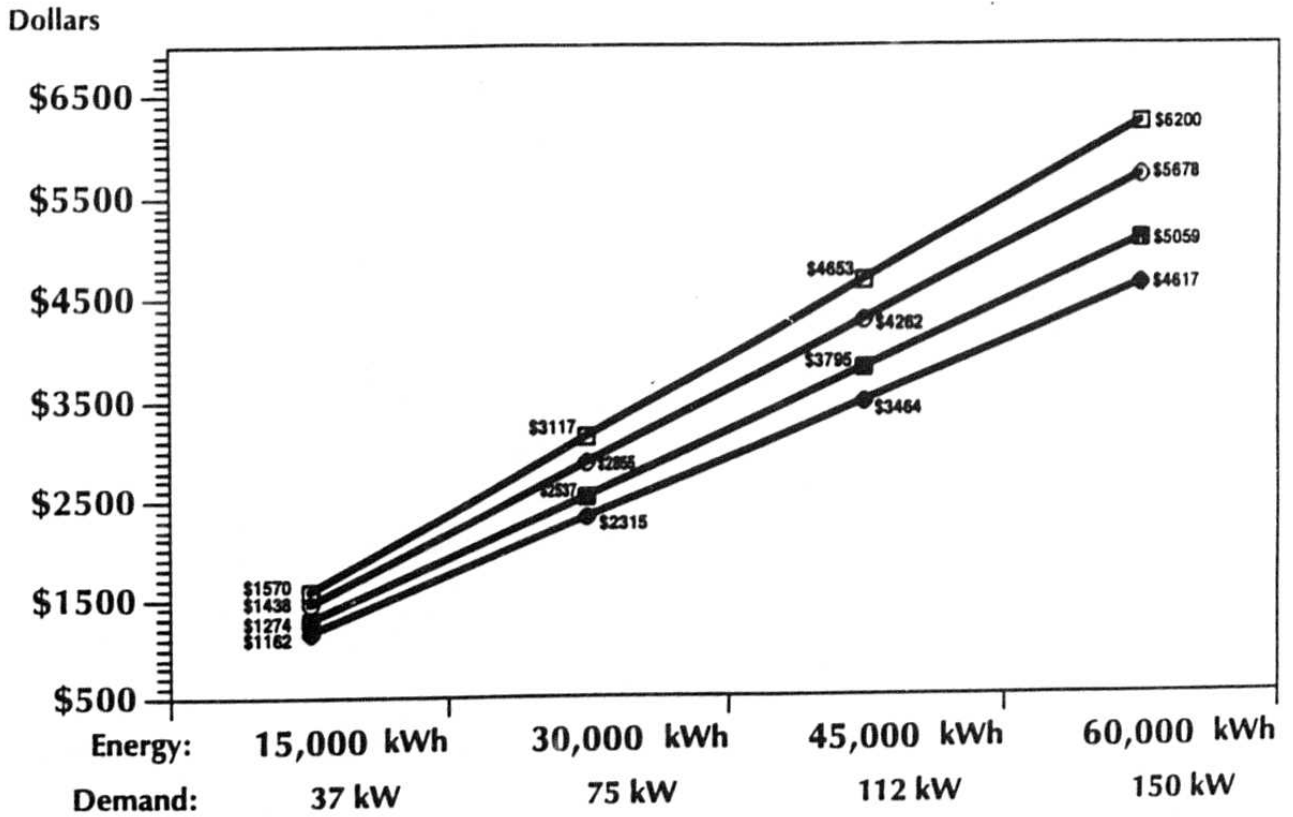
