Dear Mr. Lewis:

On November 3, 1992, I sent you a letter which set forth our firm's estimate of legal fees to complete the above-referenced rate case proceeding. That letter contained an estimate of approximately \$75,000.00 to \$100,000.00 to complete this proceeding.

At the final hearing in this matter, Forrest Ludsen was asked to provide Late-Filed Hearing Exhibit No. 71 pertaining to rate case expenses and entitled "Projection for Completion." This exhibit should include our firm's current estimate of legal fees to complete this proceeding. Our current estimate of fees is set forth below.

As in the Lehigh rate case (Docket No. 911188-WS), our estimate of legal fees to complete this rate case proceeding are based on the following hourly rates:

Joseph P. Cresse - \$150 per hour Kenneth A. Hoffman - \$140 per hour Floyd R. Self - \$120 per hour Laura L. Wilson - \$90 per hour

As of this date, our firm has billed Southern States Utilities, Inc. a total of \$149,014.91 for services (fees and costs) rendered through October 31, 1992 in this rate case. Work in progress on this rate case for services (fees and costs)

rendered through November 22, 1992 is \$26,269.50. Hence, the total amount billed and work in progress through November 22, 1992, including fees and costs, is \$175,284.41.

The primary tasks remaining on this case are as follows:

- 1) Assistance in preparation and review of late-filed hearing exhibits;
- Review and analysis of transcript from final hearing and hearing exhibits;
 - 3) Preparation of post-hearing brief;
- 4) Review Staff Recommendations and attend Agenda Conferences on February 12 (Revenue) and February 16 (Rates), 1993;
- 5) Post-Agenda Conference tasks associated with preparation and submission of tariffs and notice to customers;
- 6) Possible filing of motion for reconsideration or responding to a motion for reconsideration and possible oral argument associated therewith; and
 - 7) Miscellaneous tasks associated with all of the foregoing.

Based on the foregoing described tasks to be performed to complete this case, we estimate that our legal fees to provide these services, excluding the preparation and filing of a motion for reconsideration or response to a motion for reconsideration, will be a minimum of \$60,000.00. We note that the primary factor which could cause this estimate to be exceeded is whether the Company or the Office of Public Counsel seeks reconsideration of the Commission's final order, and, if so, the quantity and degree of complexity of the issues presented for reconsideration.
