Dear Mr. Marks:

Our review of the application in the referenced docket indicates that the following items require attention before staff will be able to continue case processing. Generally, this case involves several Rules and Statute Sections and is more or less a hybrid situation. Sections 367.031 (Original Certificate), .045 (Certificate Amendment), and .071 (Sale, Transfer), Florida Statutes, are all involved to varying degrees in this instance. Similarly, Rules 25-30.011 (Application and Scope), .030 (Notice), .032 (Applications), .033 (Original Certificate Application), .036 (Certificate Amendment), and .037 (Certificate Transfer), Florida Administrative Code, are also involved, again to varying degrees. It is not staff's intention to unduly confound this case, since it is already somewhat complex, but to ensure that the Rules and Statutory requirements are fulfilled to the extent possible in these circumstances.


-Rule 25-30.036(2)(d), Florida Administrative Code - The number of current active connections within the territory to be deleted.

-Rule 25-30.036(2)(e), Florida Administrative Code - One copy of the official county tax assessment map, or other map, showing township, range, and section with a scale such as 1"=200' or 1"=400', with the territory proposed to be deleted plotted thereon by use of metes and bounds or quarter sections, and with a defined reference point of beginning.

-Rule 25-30.036(2)(i), Florida Administrative Code - The original and two copies of the sample tariff sheets reflecting the revised service area.

-Rule 25-30.036(2)(j), Florida Administrative Code - The applicant's current certificate for possible amendment.
