This letter is responsive to the request in Mr. Carver's letter of July 15, 1999, that the documents granted confidential status by Order PSC-98-0301-CFO-TP be returned to BellSouth prior to August 18, 1999, the date confidential status expires. Order PSC-98-0301-CFO-TP granted confidentiality to only one document, 06365-94.

The document remains classified in our records as confidential by the order. However, it could not be located during a recent routine review of confidential documents on file. According to our records, it was signed out by technical staff in August of 1994 and has been in their possession since that time. After an exhaustive search by both technical staff and staff in my Division, it was concluded that the document was inadvertently marked for shredding by technical staff as the docket was being closed, and that it was destroyed.
