RESOLUTION 93-R-20

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO CONSIDER EXTENDING THE AREA OF SERVICE FOR UNITED TELEPHONE SYSTEM AND SOUTHERN BELL SYSTEM SUBSCRIBERS WHO RESIDE IN MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, some residents of various sections of Marion County are served by United Telephone and Southern Bell Telephone; and

WHEREAS, these residents in extreme northwest and southeast Marion County have occasional need to contact local government offices in the County Seat of Ocala, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the lack of toll-free dialing between these residents and the City of Ocala has hindered attempts by residents to contact various government offices located there; and

WHEREAS, residents of these areas of Marion County have expressed great interest in having their area of service extended to include the City of Ocala where most government offices are located.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Marion County Board of County Commissioners that the Florida Public Service Commission, United Telephone of Florida and Southern Bell of Florida are hereby requested to take the necessary steps to secure toll-free dialing within the County of Marion by County residents.
