We are in receipt of your letter dated March 8, 1993, and a copy of the complainant's letter dated February 26, 1993. We really do not understand what this has to do with anything since this incident happened approximately two years prior to your jurisdiction. However, in the spirit of attempted cooperation, please be advised that Ms. Gross did come to see us (Turkey Creek, Inc.) to negotiate the purchase of her lot from us. During this time we informed her of the utility requirements and connection fees and she was perfectly aware of everything prior to her purchasing the lot. I have personal knowledge that there was no coercion on our part whatsoever for Ms. Gross to purchase her lot and move to Turkey Creek. We did require, as we have with everyone else, a plastic shutoff valve and the back flow preventor which is and has been part of our requirements.

We have sent you a list of our water meter requirements for the different areas of Turkey Creek. If you cannot find this, we will be glad to send you another one for future reference.
