



COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and files its Request for Confidential Classification regarding Item 372 of Staff's Fourteenth Set of Interrogatories. In support of its Request, Southern Bell shows the following:

1. On March 1, 1993, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission requested justification for a sample list of fiber projects from 1990 and 1991. This request was in connection with Item No. 372 of Staff's Fourteen Set of Interrogatories.

2. Southern Bell has now gathered the documents requested, which contain confidential information. Therefore, Southern Bell herewith files its Request for Confidential Classification for the information contained in the documents being delivered to Staff.

3. Southern Bell has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment "A" a listing of the location in the documents of the information designated by Southern Bell as confidential, together with statements indicating why the material should be treated as proprietary

confidential business information.

4. Appended hereto in an envelope designated as Attachment "B" are two copies of the documents with the confidential information deleted.

5. Appended hereto in an envelope designated as Attachment "C" are copies of the documents with the proprietary information highlighted.

6. The information deemed to be confidential by Southern Bell and identified in Attachment "A" contains, among other things, customer specific information. The Commission has always zealously protected customer specific information in order to protect the customer's privacy and prevent a competitor of the customer from obtaining an unfair advantage. Therefore, under Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes, this information is exempt from the Open Records Act as proprietary confidential business information.

7. In addition, included in these documents is information which relates to revenues derived from services, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of Southern Bell. As such, this information is classified as proprietary confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes and is exempt from the Open Records Act.

8. In accordance with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, the information for which confidential treatment is sought is intended to be and is treated by the Company as private and has not been disclosed on a

nonconfidential basis.


