

NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), and files its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

1.

The Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff") has issued several Audit Requests in the referenced docket in connection with the NARUC/FCC Regional Audit of BellSouth. The Staff has requested, among other things, that Southern Bell make available for viewing the following information:

(a) Audit Request No. 1-040, dated March 24, 1993 - agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications and Martin/Marietta allowing Martin/Marietta to use the Company's testing laboratory to test a product.

2.

Some of the information to be reviewed by the Staff is proprietary. Included is information relating to Martin/Marietta's testing of a product in the Company's testing laboratory. The agreement signed between the Company and Martin/Marietta specifically states that no information will be disclosed to the public. Moreover, the information relates to

the competitive interests of Martin/Marietta, the disclosure of which would impair its competitive business. Thus, under Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, this information is deemed to be proprietary confidential business information, and exempt from the Open Records Act.

Because this information contains proprietary information, Southern Bell is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(b)(5), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Staff to review this information without delay. The original of this notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information. The written Staff Request is attached hereto.

- 1-40 Provide all agreements that BST has with other entities, including affiliates, regarding product testing.
- 1-41 Provide all materials distributed by Nate Jones in our March 11, 1993 meeting in Birmingham. In addition, provide the 1991 and 1992 information for all forms included in the materials distributed by Mr. Jones, including BellSouth's work program detail by category of work (see attached).
- 1-42 Provide the specific organization within BST that performs the June annual analysis for projects assigned to the R&D account as described by John Mann, Staff Manager, in our March 12, 1993 interview. Provide the number of employees and their job titles that are involved in this process.
- 1-42.1 Provide a detailed description of the June annual analysis performed for projects assigned to the R&D account. Include specifics on how regulated and nonregulated costs are split for each project. In addition, provide an example of an analysis performed on a project and the criteria utilized in achieving the outcome of that particular project.
- 1-43 For projects assigned to accounts other than R&D, provide the specific organization within BST that performs the annual analysis for these Bellcore projects as described by John Mann, staff Manager, in our March 12, 1993 interview. Provide the number of employees and their job titles that are involved in this process. In addition, provide an example of an analysis performed on a project and the criteria utilized in achieving the outcome of that particular project.
- 1-44 What organization within BST is responsible for determining the regulated/nonregulated portion of each Bellcore project that is assigned to each of the nine states in BST's region? Provide a detailed description of the process utilized in performing this split.
- 1-45 In our March 11-12, 1993 meeting in Birmingham, BellSouth staff members spoke of the "CSS" System. What does CSS represent? Provide a detailed description of the CSS system. Include the inputs that are used in the system and the outputs obtained from the system. (In the case of BellCore projects list all steps that must be taken prior to the use of this system)
- 1-46 On page 55 of the NARUC Accounting task force Phase II report on the Review of Bellcore Technical Work Efforts, November 1992, it is stated that when a concept is ready to be presented to the RBOCs, Bellcore's Network Services and Technology Process (NSTP) prepares a Prospectus. Provide an example of a project prospectus prepared
