RE: DOCKET NO. 911034-TL - Request by Broward Board of County Commissioners for extended area service between Fort Lauderdale, Hollywood, North Dade and Miami.

Issue 1: Recommendation that Broward County's request for EAS between the Fort Lauderdale, Hollywood, North Dade and Miami exchanges (Docket No. 911034-TL) be removed from the Southern Bell rate case (Docket No. 920260-TL) and reviewed separately since the hearings in the Southern Bell rate case have been postponed until 1994.

APPROVED

Issue 2: Recommendation that, based on the relocation of residents and businesses into the Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood area, due to the devastation from Hurricane Andrew in August 1992, Rule 25-4.059, F.A.C., which limits reviews of EAS to every three years, should be waived. In addition, Southern Bell should be required to conduct new traffic studies on these routes within 90 days of the date the order from this recommendation becomes final.

APPROVED with the modification that the hybrid 254 plan be implemented in the interim for all but the Pembroke Pine area. Implementation is to occur within 6 months.
