This proposed tariff filing offers two new features to Enhanced Service Providers (ESP's). These two new features are Customer Controllable Ringing and Message Waiting Indication - Audible Ring Burst. Customer Controllable Ringing provides the ESP client with the ability to control the number of ringing cycles applied before a call is forwarded to the integrated voice mail server. Message Waiting Indication - Audible Ring Burst places periodic distinctive ring bursts on the ESP client's line whenever a message is stored in the client's integrated voice mail service.
