RE: DOCKET NO. 920699-TL - Petition by residents of Alligator Point requesting extended area service (EAS) from Alligator Point to Sopchoppy, Panacea, Crawfordville, St. Marks and Tallahassee.

Issue 1: Recommendation that, since the subscriber survey met the requirements of Rule 25-4.063(6), F.A.C., St. Joe and Centel should be ordered to implement two-way, nonoptional EAS between the Alligator Point exchange and the Tallahassee, Sopchoppy, Panacea, Crawfordville, and St. Marks exchanges. These routes should be implemented as soon as possible but no later than twelve months from the issuance date of the order from this recommendation. In addition, the confidential traffic data on these routes should no longer be held confidential once nonoptional, flat rate EAS is implemented.


