PETITION OF CYPRESS VILLAGE PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION FOR INTERVENTION AND FOR RECONSIDERATION OF ORDER NO. 93-0423

Comes now Cypress Village Property Owners Association, and files this application to intervene in the above identified application and for reconsideration of the Commission Order No. 93-0423 issued March 23, 1993, and in support thereof states and alleges:

1. Cypress Village Property Owners Association is a Florida non-profit organization representing members who are residents and property owners of Cypress Village in Citrus County, Florida.

2. As shown in the attached Exhibit water and sewer cost comparison for 1991 test year usage, statewide uniform rates will result in an annual cost increase to Cypress Village residents in the amount of \$ 477,694 for a 69% percent increase.

3. Neither Cypress Village Property Owners Association nor the residents of Cypress Village received notice by bill inserts or separate mailing that Southern States Utility was seeking or that the Public Service Commission was considering statewide uniform


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rates.

4. As demonstrated above and by the attached exhibits, the adoption of statewide uniform rates is unfair, unjust and discriminatory as to Cypress Village residents.

5. In all other respects, Cypress Village Property Owners Association adopts the Motion for Reconsideration filed on behalf of Cypress and Oak Villages Association of Homosassa.
