OREMC'S STATUS REPORT

Okefenoke Rural Electric Membership Corporation ("OREMC" or "Okefenoke"), by and through its undersigned counsel, submits the following status report:

1. By Order No. PSC-92-1213-FOF-EU, issued October 27, 1992, in this docket ("Order No. 92-1213"), the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC") gave Jacksonville Electric Authority ("JEA") 120 days to submit a specific, detailed proposal for the elimination of duplicate facilities in Northern Duval County.

2. On February 22, 1993, JEA submitted a 1½ page proposal entitled, "Jacksonville Electric Authority's Plan to Eliminate Duplicative Electric Facilities" (hereinafter "JEA's Proposal"). Therein, JEA announced its intent to purchase or condemn OREMC's facilities and right to serve in Northern Duval County.

3. On March 16, 1993, OREMC filed a response to JEA's Proposal. Therein, OREMC pointed out that JEA's Proposal is not a specific, detailed proposal as required by Order No. 92-1213, that JEA was continuing to duplicate OREMC's facilities in Duval County and that the FPSC should not rely on JEA's proposal to condemn. OREMC also requested that the FPSC reject JEA's Proposal and

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

institute further proceedings to further define the territorial rights already granted in Order No. 92-1213.

4. Another 120 days have passed since OREMC filed its Response. During that period, OREMC and JEA have been negotiating in good faith to reach agreement on a plan to correct the duplication of facilities caused by JEA in Northern Duval County. At the request of the parties, the FPSC has patiently awaited the results of these negotiations.

5. Despite the continuing good-faith efforts of the parties, it has become clear to OREMC that the negotiations between JEA and OREMC have stalled. Accordingly, OREMC respectfully renews its request for the FPSC to reject JEA's Proposal, and adopt OREMC's proposal. OREMC further requests that the FPSC commence further proceedings in this docket as may be appropriate under the circumstances.
